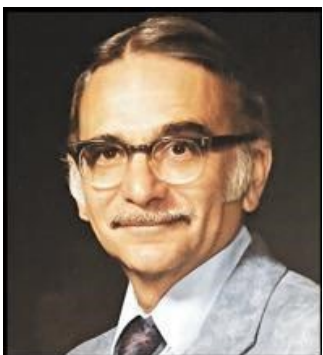

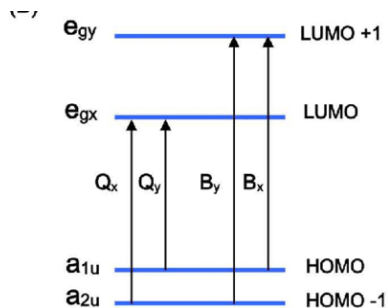
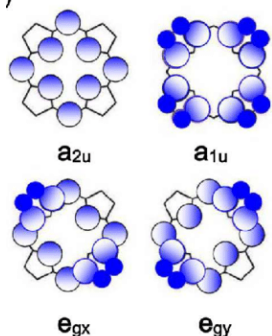

Why is grass green?

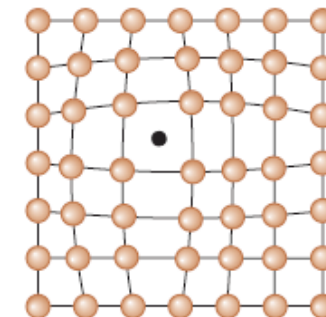


Nina Vedeneyeva

Early work on materials with anomalous dispersion.

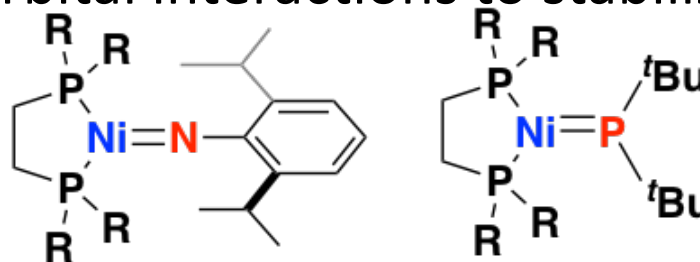


Gregory Hillhouse
