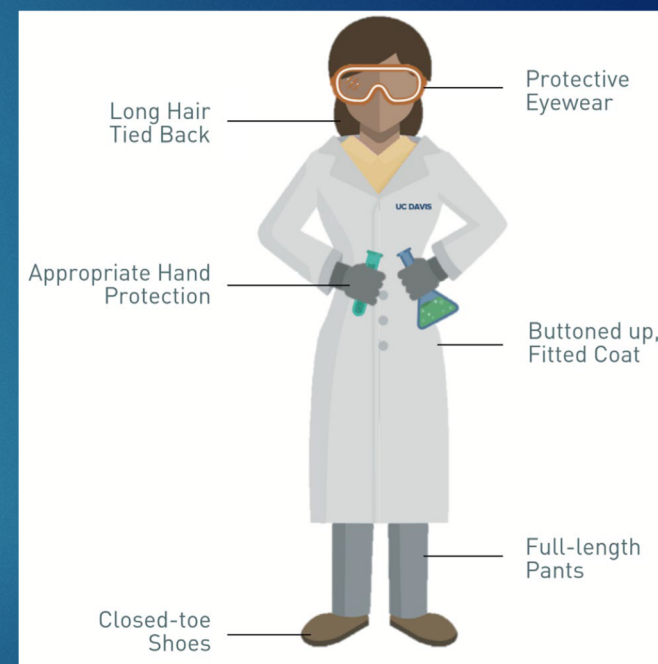
Lab Visitors & Summer Students

Documentation & Training



Short-term visiting students include lab visits, shadowing, and campus demonstrations). Long-term visiting students are summer researchers or collaborators.

- Documentation, training, & forms: contact your institution's safety office for documentation and campus-specific requirements for minors.
- Structure activities for safety: minimize the risks/hazards, outline individual lab safety requirements, and perform a lab sweep.
- "Know Before You Go": Provide safety information before students visit campus.
- Day-of Support: resources and personnel (e.g., PPE, tour guides).

Minors in the Lab

- There are special trainings/requirements for minors
 - Complete standard safety training (written & verbal)
 - Mentor training, background check for personnel
 - Specific guidance on allowed activities for minors

Activities Prohibited	
Utilizing carcinogens (Published by NTP, or IARC Group 1 or 2A)	Working with substances present on the OSHA Particularly Hazardous Substances (PHS) List
Handling teratogens/mutagens	Donning a respirator
Handling radioactive substances	Utilizing radioactive devices
Handling Risk Group 2 organisms or higher	Entering BSL-2 or higher
Research that includes animal handling **	Entering animal research facilities
Entering laboratories where biological select agents are stored and/or utilized ***	Work with class 3b or 4 lasers
